- Updates from Dr. Steve, Mrs. Imig
  - School report cards are out, huge year of growth and overall a really impressive and great report card. Hard to have high growth and high achieving at same time. Great work to this school district.
  - o 3D printer update: had submitted for grant from Society of Plastics Engineers for (2) 3D printers. Both are decently high-end. One utilizes plastics and the other will be able to cut wood and harder materials. Is exploring some additional grants. If we set up a fab lab there are grants out there of upwards of 10K+ available. Would need to have open to public during select times. Working through business office and getting checks cleared. Want to get kids exposure to the machines and get them learning to use it. Brainstorming some experiments and things they could easily learn to make.
